

## Exempt Purchase Price Sales [CRO-1265]

### Form Description

Political party executive and affiliated committees use this form to report purchases from an approved Exempt Sales Plan (CRO-2600).

Under the 'Exempt Sale', treasurers are not required to obtain the name, address and employer information for each contributor (unless an individual contributor exceeds \$50). The treasurer records the total number of each item sold and the amount raised.

Check the 'Yes' box at the top of the page if this is an amendment.

### Line-by-Line Instructions

Line 1. Indicate the plan description from the Exempt Sales Plan (CRO-2600).

Line 2. Indicate submission date of the Exempt Sales Plan (CRO-2600).

Line 3. Indicate the number of items sold at the exempt sale.

Line 4. Indicate the total amount raised at the exempt sale.

Line 5. Indicate the election cycle sum-to-date for all exempt party sales during this election cycle.

Line 6. Indicate whether or not the exempt sale was conducted according to the 'Exempt Sales

Plan' approved by the State Board of Elections' (choose Yes or No).

Line 7. Indicate whether or not any purchaser made total purchases exceeding \$50 (choose Yes or No).

Line 8. Indicate the total amount raised for exempt sales on the current page. This should be the sum of all item '4' from this page.

Line 9. Indicate the total amount raised for exempt sales on all CRO-1265 pages. This number will be included on line 11e of the Detailed Summary.
