

Non-Monetary Gifts Given to Other Committees [CRO-1330]

Form Description

If a committee **gives** an “in-kind”, non-monetary gift, service or item to another committee, it should be listed on this form. The total will **NOT** be entered in the **RECEIPTS** or **EXPENDITURES** on the **Detailed Summary** (CRO-1100) form, but will be included for information purposes at the bottom of the **Detailed Summary** (CRO-1100) form. The committee receiving the gift will continue to report the gift as an “in-kind” contribution.

When a disclosure report is amended only include changed information and check “Yes” at the top of the page.

Line-by-Line Instructions

- LINE 1. Provide the complete name of the committee or fund this report covers.
- LINE 2. Provide the ID number of the committee or fund.
- LINE 3. List each payee’s information separately. Multiple expenditures made to this payee may be listed on the appropriate lines. If this is an amendment, use Line 3 to add or remove a non-monetary gift given to other committees.
- a. Provide the payee’s complete name, mailing address and phone number.
 - b. Check the appropriate box for the type of committee registered.
 - c. Check the appropriate box for the level at which the receiving committee is registered.
 - d. This space is for any additional information that is necessary for the report.
 - e. Check the box of the appropriate type of non-monetary gift (Contribution to Candidate/ Political Committee, Coordinated Party Expenditure).
 - f. Provide a description of the gift.
 - g. List the date the gift was made.
 - h. List the fair market value of the gift.
- LINE 4. List the total sum of all non-monetary gifts on the current page.
- LINE 5. List the total sum of all CRO-1330 pages. Calculate this by adding Line 4 of all CRO-1330 pages.
